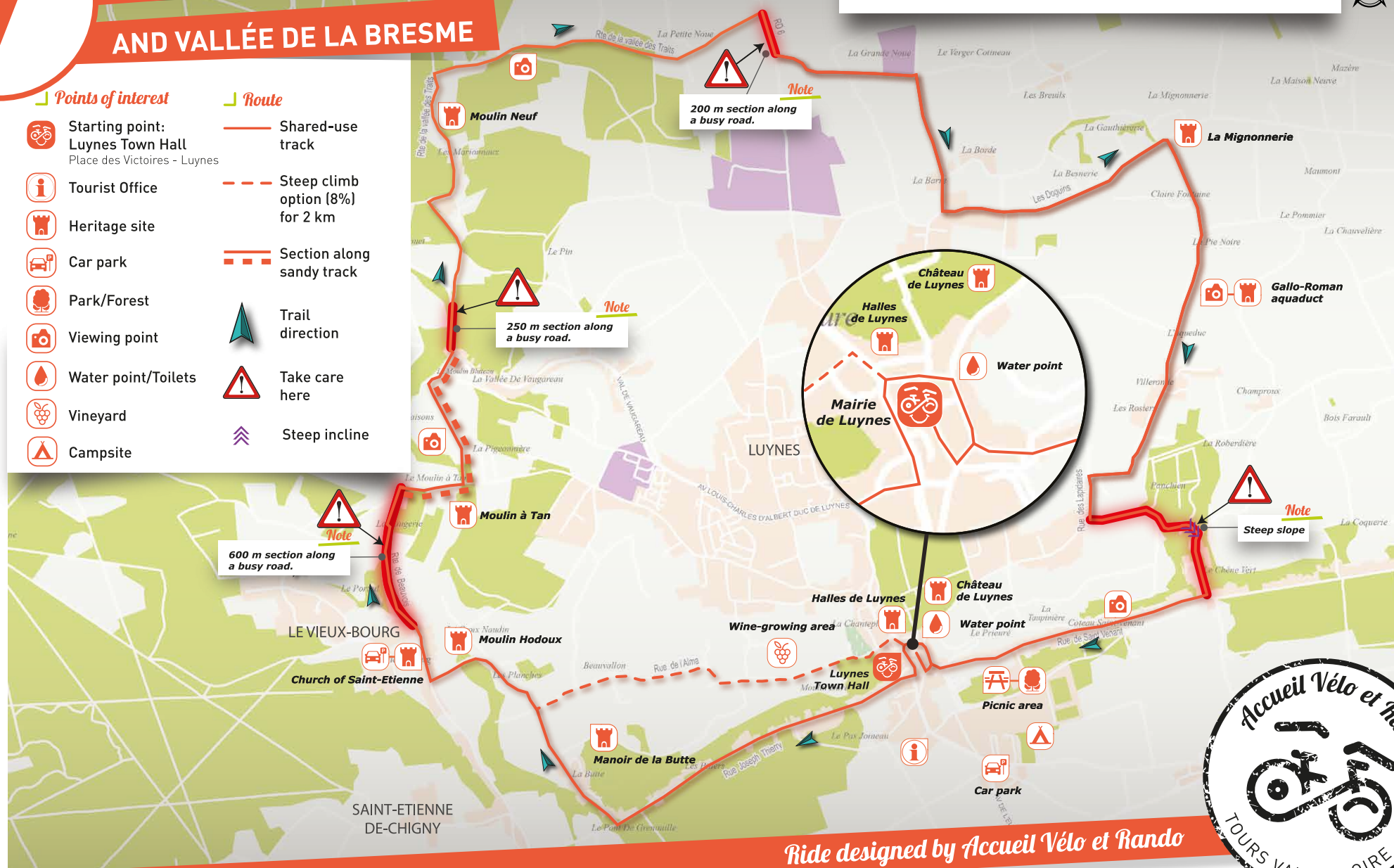

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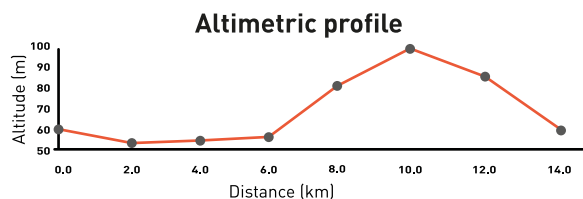
Les Halles de Luynes

Starting from the centre of Luynes, discover the 15th-century entirely covered market.

Pass through the Old Town with its historic houses and its listed 16th-century church.

Continue through the Vallée de Bresme and the Vallée des Traits down narrow roads and sandy tracks, take a breather among the trees and the Touraine houses.

Admire the view from the plateau before returning to the town centre, passing by the foot of the Gallo-Roman aqueduct, classified as a historical monument since 1862.
